We value diversity and internationalism, promoting an understanding of the wider world. We have links with a girls' school in Peru, we teach languages from Year 3, through Eco Club the girls learn and share knowledge about environmental issues.

Girls support charities near and far, collect for foodbanks and share activities such as bell ringing and bingo with residents at a local care home. They are taught to become global citizens, playing an active part in the community around them. Understanding and inclusivity mean we stand strong and united.



Strive to be resilient

Resilience means the capacity to recover quickly from difficulties. To teach it involves a necessary exposure to possible failure, yet the wonderful outcome is a 'have a go' mentality, opening up a world of possibilities.

At Redmaids' High Juniors, pupils play competitive sport from Year 3, taking part in regional and national events. They learn about teamwork and success, as well as being gracious in defeat. Our girls take on leadership positions such as House Captains and Almoners, teaching them about risk, responsibility and decision making – all essential life skills.

Our successful outdoor education clubs – orienteering, kayaking, climbing, caving and sailing – encourage critical thinking and problem-solving, alongside physical activity. The pupils thrive on the opportunity to test both their bodies and minds.

Design technology lessons introduce a more commercial aspect to product formation, while creative writing lets girls express themselves through the written word, inspired by author visits and poetry readings.
